I write further to your request for access to records under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* (FOIPPA), which we understand to include:

[...the total number of incidents reported at transit stops (both SkyTrain and Bus) from 2015-08-15 to 2016-08-15, with station by station breakdown ...]

As per my email of 2016-09-23, we are unable to provide any information pertaining to bus stops. Bus stops are not classified as transit property and, accordingly, do not have a physical address needed to query the PRIME records management system. While Transit Police do attend many incidents involving the bus system, extracting these from PRIME would be extremely laborious and time consuming.

The data to follow represents Transit Police related calls for service and interactions of primary offence codes only, as reported to Stats Canada, on SkyTrain and other transit property directly linked to the SkyTrain stations and bus loops (as discussed) during the period 2015-08-15 to 2016-08-15.

The total number of reported incidents attended by Transit Police by station and type is enclosed.
