POLICY

1. The South Coast British Columbia Transportation Authority Police Service (SCBCTAPS) will, in partnership with the communities it serves, jointly identify and seek resolution to problems of crime and disorder, on an ongoing basis.

REASON FOR POLICY

2. To maintain, at all times, a relationship with the public that enhances and reinforces the historic tradition that the police are the public and that the public are the police. The police then are only members of the public who are paid to give full-time attention to duties that are incumbent on every citizen in the interests of community welfare and existence.
