



TRANSIT POLICE Freedom of Information Request Sick Leave, Long Term Disability & Number of Employees 2010 – 2012

The Transit Police recently received a Freedom of Information request for the following information:

“The number of TP employees who are currently on long term disability, stress leave or some other form of long-term, health-related leave.

The number of sick days taken, (broken down into commissioned and civilian categories) each year by TP employees from January 1, 2010 to July 1, 2012.

The number of total paid employees (broken down into commissioned and civilian categories) each year by TP employees January 1, 2010 to July 1, 2012”

The information below is responsive to the request and has been forwarded to the Requestor.

1. The Transit Police currently have two employees on long term disability. The company does not pay for their insurance costs as this is a cost that is borne by the union. Both of these positions have been temporarily backfilled.
2. Breakdown of sick days and number of employees (Civilian and Sworn) from 2010-2012 (up to July):
